Products to be used:

SYSTIVA SEED TREATMENT FUNGICIDE (APVMA No. 70065)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 333 g/L FLUXAPYROXAD as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Disease	Rate
Onion, bulb	Neck rot (<i>Botrytis allii</i>)	60-120 mL/100 kg seed

Critical Use Comments:

- The seed treatment product should be mixed with a sufficient volume of water up to a maximum mix volume of 600 mL/100 kg seed, to ensure a slurry which results in thorough and even coverage of seed.
- Apply with an applicator designed for liquid seed treatments. Calibrate application equipment for the flow rate of the seed.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Protection of Livestock

DO NOT feed treated seed to animals. DO NOT allow treated seed to contaminate grain intended for animal consumption.

Protection of Wildlife, Fish, Crustaceans and Environment

DO NOT feed treated seed or otherwise expose to wild or domestic birds. Any spillages of treated seed, however minor, must be cleaned up immediately, preferably by recovery and re-use. If disposal is required, ensure treated seeds are thoroughly buried and not accessible to birds and other wildlife.

DO NOT contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with the chemical or used containers.

Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that State.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

The holder of the permit must notify the APVMA of new information, including relevant information in accordance with section 161 of the Schedule to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994*, in accordance with the obligation imposed by that section.
